1	Canada	"Total sexual violence" includes sexual assaults i.e. any physical contact (includes touching) with a person against their will or without proper consent; sexual assault with a weapon; aggravated sexual assault; sexual abuse and exploitation of minors; and other sexual offences.
2	Turkey	Break in series: A new recording system was applied in the year 2005 by the new Turkish Penal Code.
3	Hungary	National definition of 'total sexual violence' does differ from that of the present questionnaire; as not all sexual crimes against children are included therein. The notion of sexual violence encounters only violent sexual offences; where violence against a person or direct threat against a person's life or health is made use of. However there are certain sexual crimes against children which do not involve violence; such as seduction. These offences are excluded.
4	Latvia	Break in series: Since 01.10.2005 there is a new data structure in the Register of Criminal Offences.
